## WHITE

### **Sauvignon Blanc, Santiago, Chile**

25.00

From the Central Valley, the Santiago delivers ripe citrus, green apple and passion fruit notes with a crisp, refreshing finish.

### **Pinot Grigio, Dea del Mare, Italy**

25.00

A crisp, Sicilian Pinot Grigio that offers lovely citrus fruit aromas accompanied by soft honey undertones. Refreshing, with zesty green apple flavours.

### **Chenin Blanc, Blockhead, South Africa**

4.50 6.50 9.00 26.00

Floral, guava and citrus aromas with succulent tropical fruit on the palate and a balancing acidity. Super value, super tasty.

### **Chardonnay, Murphy's Vineyards, Murray-Darling, Australia**

4.75 7.00 9.50 28.00

A soft, un-oaked, and fruit-driven Chardonnay, with good balance and length, packed with stone fruit and melon flavours.

### **Vinho Verde, Passatempo, Lisbon, Portugal**

29.50

Citrus, white flowers, subtle passionfruit and lots of mineral freshness. Well balanced throughout, the finish is long and fruity, yet marvellously crisp.

### **Rioja Blanco, Finca Manzanos, Spain**

32.00

Fabulous pear aromas on the nose. Bright and fresh, with hints of citrus, orchard, and stone fruits. Rounded, long and balanced.

### **Picpoul de Pinet, Cave l'Ormarine, Languedoc, France**

5.50 8.25 10.50 33.00

Vibrant and fresh on the palate with ripe mango fruit, a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality. Classic Picpoul at it's best.

### **Viognier, Domaine Gayda, Languedoc, France**

5.75 8.50 11.50 34.00

Quince, herbs, and stone fruit on the nose. Fresh and intense, with flavours of apricot, bergamot, acacia and lime, with a slight bitter almond finish.

### **Grillo Appassimento, Miopasso, Sicily, Italy**

6.00 9.00 12.00 36.00

Notes of dried fruits and nuts, with hints of oranges and grapefruit. The palate is soft and well-rounded, with touches of honey on the long finish.

### **Sauvignon Blanc, Snapper Rock, Marlborough, New Zealand**

6.25 9.25 12.00 37.00

a classic, vibrant nose of tropical fruits such as passion fruit that carry through to the palate and are joined by a crisp citrus tinged edge to the mouth watering acidity.

### **Gruner Veltliner, Funkstille, Niederostereich, Austria**

36.00

Subtle exotic hints, ripe pear and fresh citrus flavours, it's a dry wine with complex flavours. The palate is rich with flavours of melon and grapefruit with a refreshing, zippy finish.

### **Bacchus Fume, Flint Vineyards, Earsham, Norfolk**

48.00

Pear tart, lime cordial and almond on the nose with a soft, creamy mid-palate that is nutty and smoky on the finish. A superb expression of Bacchus.

### **Chablis, Domaine Fournillon, Burgundy, France**

49.00

Rich and textured, but crisp and fresh with plenty of citrus fruit with lovely limey acidity running through it. Good depth with classic slatey minerality.

### **Pouilly Fume, Domaine Pierre marchand, Loire Valley, France**

54.00

A complex, concentrated example of Pouilly Fumé with well balanced, crisp gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf fruit overlaid with hints of citrus and mineral. The finish is elegant and long with hints of flint and ripe apple.

### **Puligny Montrachet, Laurent Boussey, Burgundy, France**

89.00

Rich, buttery, floral, and slightly nutty on the nose. Classic Puligny. The palate has purity and freshness, combined with orchard fruits, hints of caramel, hazelnut, and salinity. Beautiful balance and structure, energetic, rich, and elegant

## RED

### **Merlot, Santiago, Chile**

25.00

Fresh and bright with characteristic aromas of cherry and red fruits. Light and juicy on the palate with gentle acidity, and soft tannins.

### **Sangiovese, Ke Bonta, Italy**

4.25 6.25 8.50 25.00

A fresh, medium-bodied style with red and black berry fruit characters, and a hint of spice balanced by tangy acidity.

### **Shiraz, Blockhead, South Africa**

4.50 6.75 9.00 27.00

It's fresh, vibrant, positively thumping with sappy cherry fruit. The grip is there but perfectly balanced with a classy spiciness.

### **Carignan, Montaignan, France**

28.00

Typically juicy, with lots of delicious red fruits, a lick of oak adding some vanilla, and soft tannins at the finish. Every mouthful is so enjoyable - excellent value!

### **Shiraz/Cabernet, The Wrong Un, One Chain Vineyards, Australia**

30.00

The 'Wrong Un' is a rich, well-balanced example of the Aussie classic blend of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon. It has lush black fruits coupled with a touch of wood-spice, liquorice and cassis that follows through to a delicious velvety finish.

### **Malbec, Man Meets Mountain, Mendoza, Argentina**

5.50 8.25 11.00 33.00

A harmonious Malbec, packed full of blueberry, blackcurrant and plum and a complex and delicious finish. Everything you would expect from Mendoza Malbec, and more.

### **Primitivo, Miopasso, Puglia, Italy**

5.75 8.50 11.50 34.00

Full of rich black cherries, blackberries and plums with a savoury feel, good texture and smooth, rounded tannins.

### **Rioja Crianza, Lopez de haro, Spain**

5.90 8.75 11.50 35.00

Deep red cherry colour, aromas of ripe red fruit and liquorice combined with coffee and vanilla. Smooth and velvety on the palate with sweet and ripe tannins. Aged in French and American oak barrels during 18 months.

### **Porta da Ravessa Tinto, Adega de Redondo, Alentejo, Portugal**

34.00

Lifted, bright ruby intensity with wild berries which mingle harmoniously with elegant floral notes of violet and lilac. The palate is focused and layered with cherries, blackcurrants and un-hindered by oak.

### **Morgon, Caves de Fleurie, Beaujolais, France**

38.00

This Morgon is abundant in black fruits, including blackberries, cherries, and blackcurrants, gently topped with a touch of spice. Soft and silky tannins support the superb balance mouth-watering acidity.

### **Ribera del Duero, Emilio Moro, Finca Resalso, Spain**

39.00

Aromas of smoky oak and roasted black cherries. In the mouth, it's supple with abundant ripe dark fruit on the palate. There's a firm grain of tannin on the finish. Richness is lifted by a zest of acidity. Rich, but deliciously fresh and balanced.

### **Montagne-St Emilion, Franc Baudron, Bordeaux, France**

43.00

Bright and intense in colour with aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry and oak notes. Well balanced, powerful and velvety. A classy Bordeaux that is drinking beautifully.

### **Pinot Noir, The Crusher, Clarksburg, California, USA**

45.00

Bold, fresh aromas of sweet morello cherry, dark chocolate and subtle pepper spice. This expressive wine is smooth and graceful with juicy cranberry fruit, black tea, violet flavours with hints of smoky oak. Well-balanced with robust fruit, fine grained tannins and good acidity which leads to a flavourful and lengthy finish.

### **Chateauneuf du Pape, Chateau Fargueirol, Rhone Valley, France**

55.00

Full-bodied, creamy and supple in feel, it delivers waves of ripe black cherries and plums along with a touch of mocha. It's tannic but ripe and turns silky on the long, mouthwatering finish.

<b>Pinot Grigio Rosé, Dea del Mare, Italy</b>	4.25	6.25	8.50	25.00
This elegant, crisp and dry Pinot Grigio Blush. Delicate aromas of summer fruits and bursts with flavours of strawberry and raspberry follow through to the palate with a balancing acidity.				
<b>St Louis de Provence, Estandon, Provence</b>	5.95	8.75	11.90	35.00
Fresh, vibrant and pale pink in colour. Dry in style with aromatic rose petals on the nose, this wine follows through with notes of cranberry and strawberry fruits on the palate with a mouthwatering finish.				
<b>Les Deux Anges, Ch. L'escarelle, Provence</b>				49.00
Aromas of pink cherries and nectarines with dried tangerine peel, almonds and dried flowers. Medium-bodied and creamy with some salinity to it. Crisp and juicy with a fleshy finish. This is an archetypal Provence Rose.

<b>Beppe Morchetta Spumante, Veneto, Italy</b>	5.00	28.00
Delicate white peach and citrus notes, with an appealing bitter twist on the finish. Fine bubbles, with appealing fruity character through to the finish.		
<b>Blanquette de Limoux, Antech, Languedoc, France</b>		37.00
Limoux is the birthplace of traditional method sparkling wine, some 100 years before Dom P 'invented' it. The nose expresses the spring flowers and fresh tree fruits. The palate is lively, harmonious and round. We have the feeling to bite in a very delicate granny smith apple.		
<b>Charmat Rose, Flint Vineyard, Norfolk</b>	9.00	50.00
Summer in a glass. Red berries on the nose that is reminiscent of Summer Fruit Pudding! This fruit carries forward to the palate, which is soft and round with a slight caramelisation and refined effervescence.		
<b>1er Cru Champagne, Pierre Bertrand, France</b>	11.00	65.00
Pinot-dominated, it's deep copper/gold and wonderfully peachy and lush, explosively juicy, and cracking value. The extended bottle ageing of this wine (6-8 years) is way longer than most NV Champagnes and lends the wines its weight and character. But it's also fresh and lemony which is such a great combination.		
<b>Louis Roederer, Brut NV Champagne, France</b>		90.00
Perhaps the finest of the Grande Marque Champagnes? Fine bubbles and a nose of fresh fruit and hawthorn. Smooth, complex palate mingling flavours of apple and pear with blackberries, raspberries and cherries. This is a structured and elegantly mature wine, lively on the mouth with a smooth palate.
